

Registration for the NC Breathing Equipment/Firefighter Survival School:

This course is the premier fire training school that prepares experienced firefighters to operate in smoke and heat conditions to create survivable environments during crisis situations. This is an advanced training class that is physically and psychologically demanding and is designed for capable and qualified individuals.

Pre-Registration is required! Registration is through a managed lottery

Enrollment is limited to 60 participants per class

Maximum of two (2) students per agency will be accepted. You are encouraged to have as many firefighters within your agency apply with the knowledge that only two (2) per agency will be accepted.

There is a non-refundable registration fee of \$350 per student and must be paid prior to the start of the school. *Additional fee of \$129 will be charged to students outside of North Carolina. Fees billed to the student upon acceptance.

Must be a certified firefighter for at least 3 years! Certification must meet the NFPA 1001, current edition, for Firefighter II.

The link and the QR code will take you to the Gaston College web page for the NCBES. The registration link will not be live until April 1st at 8am and will close April 15th at 8am.
