Reporting AFFF Foam use

- The NC legislative mandated that all Fire Service agencies across North Carolina **SHALL** report the AFFF foam in their inventory and every time that it is used to NCDOI – Office of State Fire Marshal Office.
- This is to be documented in the state's ImageTrend Elite database.

How to report the use of AFFF Guide

- This is a step-by-step guide for an agency, that doesn't use ImageTrend Elite, to get to the form to report that you used AFFF foam during an incident call.

**** This is only done when you used AFFF foam.***

This will **NOT** replace your full NFIRS data report that you will do in your reporting software and send to the state.


You will reach out to OSFM to get a login to access ImageTrend Elite. The last page of this guide will tell you who to call or email for your agency log in.
