The code volumes publication is in various stages, and several are fully accepted and at the publisher getting ready for first editions. See the following link for any future meetings:

As of this writing, (July 2024) all code volumes have been approved by the Rules Review Commission (RRC). The 2024 NC Energy Conservation Code (NCECC) is on hold pending a legislative review in the long session in 2025 unless executive or

legislative action is taken in advance. The 2018 NCECC with NC amendments will remain in effect until further notice. The 2024 NC Building Codes will be published and available this fall with an effective date of 1/1/25. However, adoption and approval delays resulting from the Rules Review Commission of the NC Office of Administrative Hearings process under NCGS Chapter 150B and the incorporation of new laws within the codes as directed by the NC General Assembly during the code development process have delayed publication of the codes by 6 months. The NCBCC is going to discuss a grace period in the next couple of weeks and announce more information at the 9/10/24 NCBCC meeting and public hearing. A six-month grace period is being discussed and is anticipated.

Here is a status as of 7/15/24 of the 2024 NC Building Codes publication schedule and the RRC approval process.

Administrative Code	2024 NC Administrative Code and Policies: Approved at the 1/31/24 RRC meeting. ICC is currently publishing the first draft.
NC Electrical Code	2023 NC Electrical Code: Approved at the 2/28/24 RRC meeting.
Plumbing Code	2024 NC Plumbing Code: Approved at the 2/22/24 RRC meeting. ICC is working on the draft.
Residential Code	2024 NC Residential Code: Approved at the 2/22/24 RRC meeting. ICC is working on the draft.
Mechanical Code	2024 NC Mechanical Code: Approved at the 4/30/24 RRC meeting. Entering publication phase.
Fuel Gas Code	2024 NC Fuel Gas Code: Approved at the 4/30/24 RRC meeting. Entering publication phase.
Existing Building Code	2024 NC Existing Building Code: Approved at the 6/26/24 RRC meeting. Entering publication phase.
Building Code	2024 NC Building Code: Approved at the 6/26/24 RRC meeting. Entering publication phase.

Energy Code (not for 1- and-2 family dwellings)	2024 NC Energy Conservation Code: Approved at the 4/30/24 RRC meeting with the exception of Section R402 Building Thermal Envelope. More than 10 letters of objection were received by the RRC so this code is under legislative review in the 2025 long session. The effective date of this is unknown at this time.

Remember, the Residential standing committee had introduced (in the March 2023 meeting) a submittal that would keep the Chapter 11 (Energy), Chapters 12-23 (Mechanical) and Chapter 24 (Fuel Gas) the same as the 2018 version of the NC Residential Code. As noted in the previous newsletter, NCGS Session Law 2023-108 prohibits further action on several of the code volumes and combinations of code volumes that were being considered by the Building Code Council. The list of codes in Table 1 reflect the limitations of the statutes.
