IMPORTANT NOTICE

Set Up Contractor's License Course and Test Notice

Every set up contractor licensee must employ at least one qualifier. A qualifier is an individual that supervises set up contractor activities on the job site. Each manufactured home set up project must have a qualifier on-site for a majority of the job. In order to obtain a set up contractor's license, at least one company qualifier is required to pass a written test which will be administered at:

NC Dept. of Insurance Office of State Fire Marshal 325 North Salisbury St. Raleigh, NC 27603

The test will consist of 60 multiple choice questions with a two-hour time limit. A total of 42 correct answers will be required in order to receive a set up contractor's license. The test will be open book, using the **State of North Carolina Regulations for Manufactured Homes, 2019 Edition**. You must bring your own Code book or purchase one on test day. Although not absolutely necessary, you may also wish to bring a calculator. A brief review session of approximately two to two and a half hours will be given beginning at **9:00 AM** on the test day. No one will be admitted after the test has officially started.

Scheduled test dates are:

Sept. 17, 2020 Nov. 19, 2020 Jan. 21, 2021 Mar. 18, 2021 May 20, 2021

Your completed application must be received by the Manufactured Building Division not later than <u>30</u> <u>**DAYS**</u> prior to the scheduled date in order to be admitted to the examination. Your completed application will serve as your registration for the test.
